HOW TO ARRIVE THERE

By plane :

The main Henri Coanda Otopeni International Airport is situated at 15 km distance from Bucharest in the Northern part of the city, on Bucharest- Ploiesti DN 1 Highroad.

The transfer from Henri Coanda Otopeni International Airport will be provided by :

- **Taxi** available in the airport may bring you to your hotel destination. Tariffs are ranging between Euro 8-10 /km.
- Best Western Parc Hotel **Shuttle bus** . Transfer fee is Euro 15 from airport to Hotel Best Western Parc. Available for the participants booking rooms in this hotel.
- At the participants' request, our Faculty could assure free transportation by van or car from Otopeni Airport to the University Campus or hotels where the participants have already reserved rooms at .

By train :

The main Bucharest Railway Station is named "Gara de Nord" (Northern Railway Station) where you may take a taxi to bring you to the University campus or your hotel destination. Tariffs are ranging between Euro 5 -10 /km.

The means of conveyance linking the university with the Northern Railway Station are the following buses: 105, 205, 282 in combination with Tram no.41. Other buses with stops close to the university are : 13, 331, 783, 301.

At the participants' request, our Faculty could assure free transportation by van or car from Northern Railway Station to the University Campus at the participants request .

INVITATION LETTER

If requested by participants, an official letter of invitation will be sent by symposium secretariat. We have to mention that the official letter of invitation will not guarantee any payment of expenses such as fees, travel or hotel accommodation for the symposium.

CLIMATE

Romania has a temperate continental climate, specific to Central and Eastern European Countries. The month of May is normally sunny with temperatures ranging between 22 /27 Celsius degrees during the day and 14-17 Celsius degrees during the night.

VISAS

For the EU and American citizens with a valid passport , there is no visa required. All other visitors will need visa, which should be obtained prior to the arrival, from Romanian Diplomatic Missions' Offices in your country. CURRENCY

The Romanian currency is "LEU" which comes in bank notes of 1 , 5, 10, 50, 100, 200, 500 and coins of 1, 5, 10, 50 " BANI". The exchange rate is 1 Euro = 4.3 LEI. Facilities for exchange of currency are available at the airport, hotels, banks and exchange offices.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN BUCHAREST

Bucharest 's means of conveyance are represented by buses, trams , trolleybuses and underground (that we normally call "Metro") , operating from 5.00 a.m. to 11.00 p.m. Tickets and cards can be brought from RATB Kiosks, located in the main stops for ground transportation or in every underground station.

Bus, Tram, Trolley ticket is :

- One fare ticket - LEI 2.5

Metro ticket is :

- One two fare Card – LEI 3

INSURANCES

The symposium fee does not include insurance. All participants should arrange for their own insurance in their country of origin.

ELECTRICITY

Electric power is AC 220 V, 50 Hz.
